Just a few things members should be aware of that were discussed at the Zoom members meeting yesterday morning....

<u>Details for Lina Lagreca</u> – As we announced last week, one of our long time members from Sir William Osler, Lina Lagreca passed away suddenly. We had a moment of silence for her at the start of our meeting yesterday and we are passing along the following details from her family. A service for Lina will be held on Wednesday at Friscolanti Funeral Home on Barton St. Due to Covid restrictions, service will be for family only and we are sharing in case anyone wanted to send an arrangement. Please don't include anything with yellow carnations as Lina was NOT a fan of yellow carnations.

Afternoon Hours — We shared the info we have from our staff relations meeting last week about the afternoon hours. We decided not to have to have everyone vote on a letter of agreement, but rather encourage the employer to use the provision in Appendix A about when students or staff aren't in buildings. So, this Thursday there will be an email from Bob Avery about hours for next week.
