



Members Update for January 14th, 2022

<u>Staff Relations</u> — At our Executive meeting on Tuesday the Executive proposed and passed a motion to suspend all further Staff Relations meetings with the employer until further notice. This is in direct response to what we feel have been unwarranted and excessive actions towards our members by the employer. The text of the email that I sent read as follows: "Due to the recent bold and unreasonable actions taken by the employer against CUPE 4153 members, the Local Executive met Tuesday and passed a motion to temporarily suspend all staff relations meetings until further notice. The Local will continue to discuss issues with the employer within the grievance process as outlined in the collective agreement."

Hello everyone, we just finished doing schedules in Nora Henderson and we are not happy we have asked management for an extra 10 minutes to complete the stairs and they said No you will get 5 minutes. Management has asked our members to do the stairs while being timed this is not good. Blake Corkill sent an email to Bob Avrey about our concerns. We have a school with lots of issues it is Salt fleet, our members do not want to sweep or wash the floors because it has food on it and they don't want to do grounds. There was a temporary schedule put in there because we have construction in the library. Please be very careful refusing to do your job it is not looking good for caretaking when there is a refusal of wok. Dave Winger said please check the school before you post we are not going to come in and change schedules just because you don't like what is on it.

Marilyn MacAloney has a question "How do you go about getting a caretaker position put in a large elementary school?" Mark Lachowicz said it goes by square footage and we know of 3 school that may be getting a caretaker in March.

Danny Catanyag asked a question "The administrator has asked our members to open up doors and close them at different times of the day this is being asked for High school buildings but there is no time allowed on our schedules for this to happen so what are we to do?" Blake Corkill said we have spoken to Bob Avrey and if this is not resolved then we are going to file a grievance under not giving us notice for a change in a policy or practice. This is ridiculous if something happens while the doors are opened then that is not our problem nor is it our responsibility nor will we ever be blamed for that issue.

Nominations and Elections

Blake Corkill said "I am going to announce right now that Sunday January 9,2022 at 10 am we are going to have a special meeting to deal with the purposed bylaw amendments. The by laws have been approved by the by law committee as well as the executive since May 2021 we have not had quorum since so thank you for attending this meeting so we can get this done. Sometime over the Christmas break I will be sending out a package with all the purposed amendments for the bylaws."

Blake Corkill said we are a little bit behind when it comes to our bargaining committee our by laws state we must have a bargaining team in place within 6 months of our contract ending. We have come up with dates for this so January 16,2022 there will be a call for nominations for the bargaining committee. We will then give the people that got nominated a 1-week window to accept or decline that will put us at January 23,2022 once we have that in place, we will give the

nominated people 2 weeks to put together their literature to be put on our website that will bring us to February 6,2022 and the election will be February 7,2022 it will be an online vote.

Prior to nominations we need an election committee if anyone is interested, please email me we need 3 people, and they cannot be on the executive and do not plan on running for anything.

Patrick Cumbo said Blake Corkill can you tell us how many people are needed for the bargaining committee? Yes, the president and chief steward are on it automatically and we need 5 more members to form this committee so altogether 7 people are on this committee.

Elections committee

We need 3 people to run the elections and make sure it is done right and fair, the president will appoint the 3 people and then it is voted on by the membership.

Geoff Thompson said that Lynn Babich would like to be on this committee so can we not bring this as a motion to the membership to vote now so that Lynn is confirmed.

Blake Corkill would like to do a food drive and put a box in the caretaker's office in every school and it be picked up the week of December 13 and be donated to the Good Sheppard. All members on this call agreed to this.

Mark Lachowicz said he would like to let the membership know that Bob Avrey gives me a report everyday about absenteeism and I just want you guys to know Monday 124 people were absent Tuesday 125 were away Wednesday 125, Thursday 137 and Friday 151. It cost the board \$50,000 dollars a day for absenteeism.

Patrick Cumbo said that out of those numbers there is only about 20 people that are on an approved leave. The board is getting very aggressive with absenteeism, and they can ask for a FAF form on the first day if they suspect abuse of sick time, it is in our collective agreement.

Blake Corkill said it would not surprise me if the board stopped all overtime and makes the school go on priority cleaning which is bad. Our sections will not be cleaned, and the schools will be a mess and that does not look good for Cupe.

Marilyn MacAloney asked when can we have in person meetings again? Blake Corkill said we will discuss this at the next executive meeting.

Stephen Clarkson asked When we have in person meetings can we still have a zoom meeting for the people that can not make it in person meeting? Blake Corkill said yes, we will have to do this side by side at the same time.

Dan LeBlanc asked what can we do about easy connect the permanent people are not getting the head caretakers role when they are at the school? Blake Corkill said that on the first day a casual can go in and after that whoever is a permanent person can bump them and do the 2nd day of head caretaker's position.

Peter Bowker said that the new seniority list will be put out in February 2022.

Geoff Thompson wanted to remind people that Blake Corkill, Patrick Cumbo and Darlene Barrick are at the National Convention November 22-26 so please call someone else if there is a problem.
