Number of votes cast: 182

Bargaining Update - Next Friday, August 5th, our Local will begin the process of Local bargaining with the HWDSB. Our first meeting will not have any proposals or actual language change discussions. The purpose of the meeting is to meet and greet the bargaining team members from the HWDSB, go over the Central/Local split in bargaining parameters and discuss the ground rules for bargaining. By law we are required to meet with the employer within a set time frame now that the Central/Local split in bargaining items has been finalized by the OSBCU, the Crown and the CTA. Our next scheduled meeting for Local Bargaining will not be until September and prior to that, your Bargaining Committee will set up a members meeting to discuss our Local Bargaining Priorities with anyone interested.
