<u>OSBCU Leadership Conference</u> - Over the weekend, Michelle Madley, Laurie Penner and myself were in Toronto all weekend for an OSBCU Conference on the state of our Central Bargaining progress, the possibility of a Central Strike and many other current issues. I want to thank Michelle and Laurie for giving up an entire weekend and family time to stay informed and up to date and also for helping me (after being away without cell service for a week) to get caught up on everything myself. It's members like these two strong women who make our Local what it is and keep everything running for all of us. If noboby gave up some time or their talents and sat back and just waited for things to be handed to them – nothing would ever get done.

I can share with you that Local leaders from across the province unanimously approved a call for Locals to take a Central Strike Vote in September from all 55,000 OSBCU members. That doesn't mean we are going on strike no matter what Skinny Jeans Lecce says in the media. It means that every single one of you will have the opportunity to tell this government what you think of their ridiculous proposed wage increases, job security language, staffing levels and supports for students.

IF we are in a position to strike, there are a TON of things that need to be done. We need people to take attendance on picket lines, monitor what's happening, deal with problems, direct media questions to the proper people, etc etc. It doesn't matter what your seniority is – if you want to be involved, we will find you a place to help out!
